**Navigating Coronavirus (COVID19)**

On Monday, March 10, 2020 CCI Human Resource Manager, Rebecca Gigante, had the opportunity to attend an informative seminar put on by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) regarding COVID19. The following information is being provided with the goal of minimizing the impact of COVID19 at our communities.

**What is Coronavirus (COVID19)?**

COVID19 is a respiratory illness caused by a virus that can spread from person to person. Symptoms can include fever, cough, and difficulty breathing. Risk is dependent on exposure. **Minimizing exposure is important.**

**CDC Recommended Best Practice Prevention Techniques:**

- Wash your hands several times per day with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds.
- Hand washing remains the single best way to prevent the spread of germs; however, if soap and running water are not available, hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol can be used.
- Thoroughly rinse your hands with running water and dry completely (germs transfer more easily when hands are wet).
- Keep fingernails short and clean and limit jewelry on hands.
- Ensure any wounds, cuts, or other skin lesions are covered.
- Practice social distancing. Social distancing means that you actively keep yourself away from other people, especially crowds, when possible.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then immediately throw the tissue in the trash.
- **Avoid touching your face! (eyes, nose and mouth)**

**Action Steps for Residents:**

- Residents are encouraged to limit visitors to the building and to their unit for the safety of all residents and staff.
- If you are sick or having any symptoms, please stay in your apartment.
- Clean and sanitize frequently touched surfaces often, like your restroom.
- Instead of visiting the office, please **call** or **email** the property manager or service coordinator.
- We encourage you to inform the property manager if you have symptoms of or have been diagnosed with COVID19.
  - CCI management will make every effort to protect the privacy of all residents reporting symptoms.

**You will see the following changes happening around the property:**

- Employees entering your apartment may be wearing latex gloves, dust mask, and safety glasses. This is to help prevent the spreading of germs.
- Non-emergency unit work orders may be postponed.
- Our community area surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized frequently.
