Subject: COVID-19 Update-URGENT!

As you've been hearing, the COVID-19 virus is coming back with a vengeance. We are seeing record numbers of new cases daily throughout the United States. The death toll continues to rise at an alarming rate. 26 states have now 'paused' or are rolling back re-opening plans.

Given the severity of the COVID-19 threat to our residents and staff, community common areas will remain closed until further notice. Management staff will keep office doors closed and managers will continue to meet with residents by appointment only. To ensure our buildings continue to meet REAC maintenance standards, we remain committed to conducting annual unit inspections and addressing maintenance needs in a timely manner. **Visitors, unless absolutely necessary, should not enter the building.**

Believe in the power of masks

Studies continue to overwhelmingly support the benefits of wearing a mask. Please wear a mask **at all times** when in the common areas of the building.

Studies now estimate that nearly 50% of COVID transmission is caused by Asymptomatic or Pre-symptomatic carriers. **That means that any person you are interacting with might have the virus and not know it.**

We all **MUST** be committed to COVID safety protocols. Dropping your guards, even momentarily, could have a tragic impact on your family, friends or our CCI employees.

Please don't become a COVID statistic!

REMEMBER, the CDC recommends that you do the following;

1. Wear your Personal Protective Equipment (mask, gloves, goggles)
2. Avoid large crowds
3. Stay 6 feet away from ANYONE not in your safety 'bubble'
4. If you socialize, do it outdoors but maintain a safe distance from other people
5. Wash your hands several times per day with soap & water
6. **Don't touch your face!!**
